

## Building Chords

Here are the instructions to build several other 4-part, aka “jazz” chords from sevenths chords.

### Maj 7

Raise the b7 of a seventh chord 1 fret.

### 6

Lower the b7 of a seventh chord 1 fret.

### m7

Lower the 3rd of a seventh chord 1 fret.

### m7b5

Lower the 5th of a minor seventh chord 1 fret.

### o7 (Diminished 7th)

Lower the b7 of a minor seventh flat five chord 1 fret.

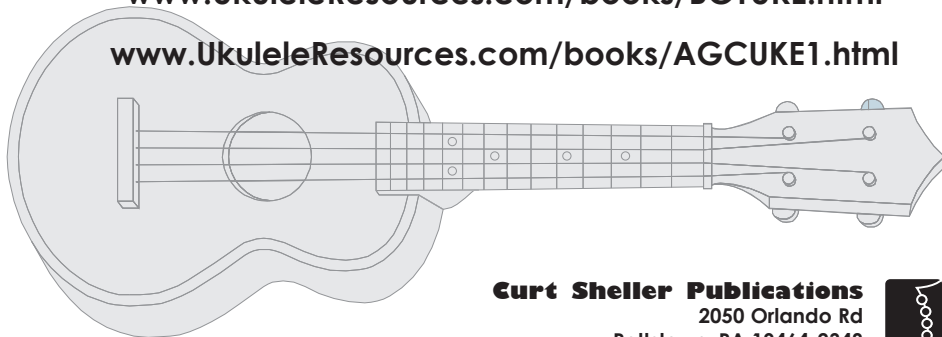
### +7 (Augmented 7th)

Raise the 5th of a seventh chord 1 fret.

If your goal is to expand your chord vocabulary, *A Guide to Advanced Chord for Ukulele - “Jazz” Chords* is your answer.

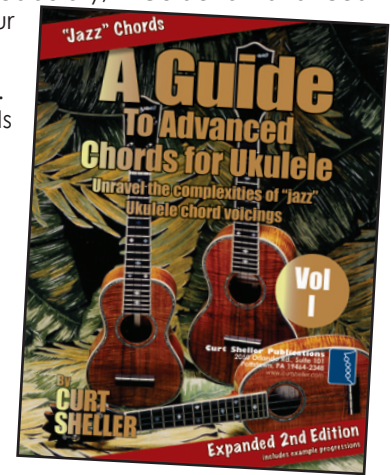
Commonly referred to as “jazz” chords. The *Advanced Guide to Ukulele Chords Volume I* provides detailed information on voicing 4-part chords.

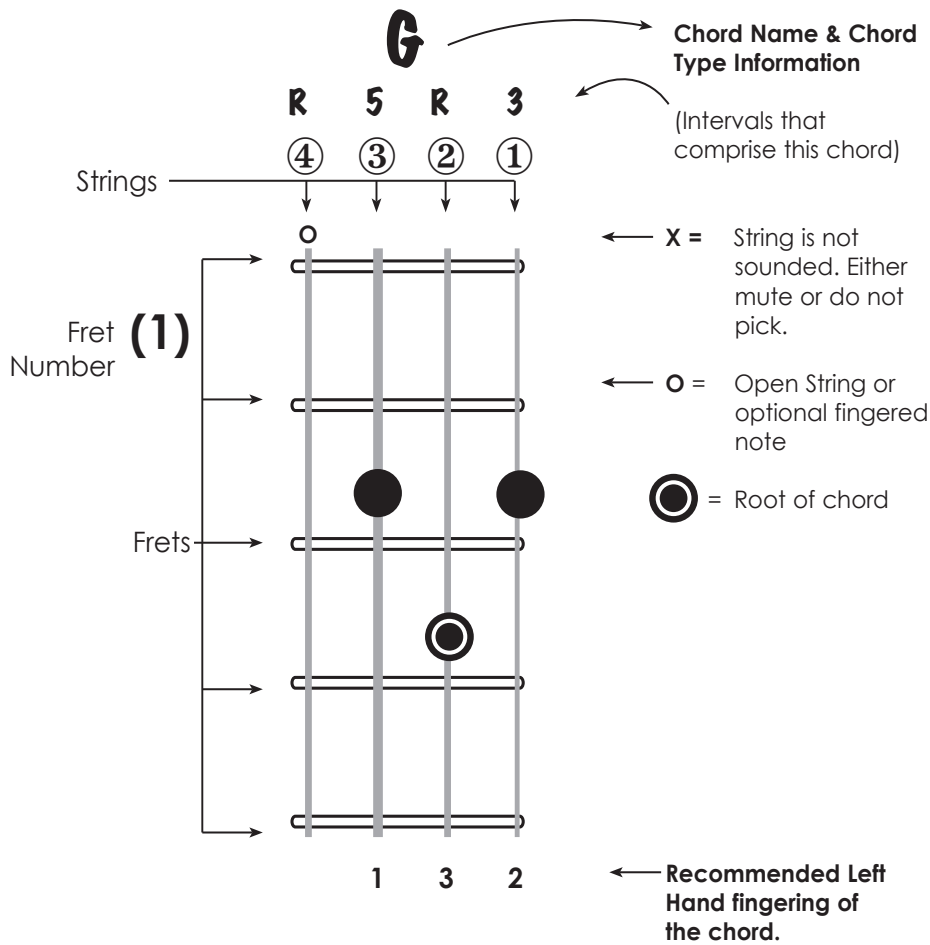

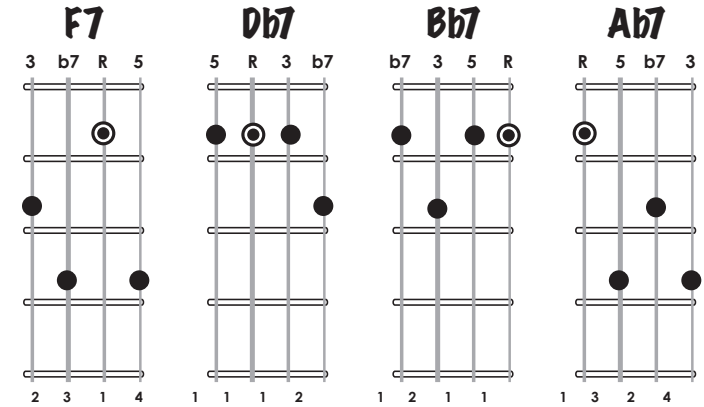

# The Chord Diagram - Explained

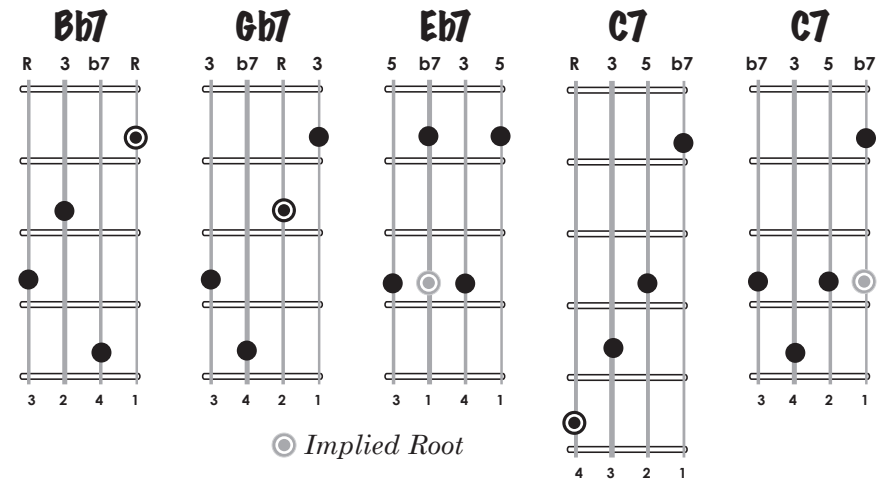


**4-Part Movable Seventh Chord**  
forms from the book **A Guide to Ukulele Chords**. A Seventh chord contains the intervals **R 3 5** and **b7** (based on a major scale).



## ADDITIONAL CHORD FORMS

4-part movable Seventh chord forms. Some voicings contain duplicate intervals with the root or fifth of the chord being displaced.



From a few basic chord shapes and an understanding of how chords are constructed your chord vocabulary can be dramatically increased without memorizing countless additional shapes.
